Adolph "Dolph" C. Arlotti Jr., age 76; Robinson Twp. (formerly West Deer) passed away on December 22, 2024. He was born on January 22, 1948 to the late Adolph and Margaret (Stinebiser) Arlotti. He is survived by his beloved wife of 32 years, Pamela Dalton-Arlotti Esq.
