Aubrey had been courageously fighting a substance use addiction for a number of years but succumbed to it in the end. But it is not the end. Aubrey was a woman of strong faith and has passed through the gates of Heaven, where there are no addictions and no struggles. She is at peace.

She will be forever missed by her precious children, Shayla, Cayden, and Jaidlyn, her mother, Donna Ferguson, her "step-father," Gary Scharff, her brothers Paul and Raymond Ferguson, her very dear and special boyfriend Fred Megill, and countless other friends. Aubrey was pre-deceased by a brother Mark, and her loving father, Duane Ferguson, who she always carried a special place in her heart for.

In high school, she was captain of the cheerleading squad at Hampton High School where she graduated in the year 2000. Aubrey was very talented in music and sang for the Childrens Festival Chorus, the Junior Mendlesohn Choir, and led worship for her small church in Bellevue.

She also enjoyed writing music, and playing her piano and guitar. In later years, as her dependence on substances became a bigger struggle and

recovery seemed more elusive, she nonetheless offered support, encouragement and acceptance to all whom she encountered that were affected by this insidious disease. All who knew her felt blessed for having known her.

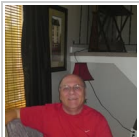
