August 10, 1964 - November 11, 2022

Diane Lynn (Conner) Troya, age 58, died November 11, 2022, at Shadyside Hospital, just 12 days after learning that she was suffering from cancer. She was born August 10, 1964, in Framingham, Massachusetts, to the late Robert and Irene Conner, and was a graduate of Leechburg Area High School.

Diane had formerly worked in the health care field and enjoyed listening to the stories of her elderly clients. She relished time spent with family and friends, karaoke at the Vandergrift VFW, and watching Hallmark movies. She was an enthusiastic Pittsburgh Steelers fan, glued to her TV set on game day, and was delighted when Kenny Pickett was named the starting quarterback. Diane voted by mail-in ballot, and although her health had seriously declined by election day, she was pleased with the results of the 2022 midterm election. She is survived by her daughters, Jocasta and Santina; by her granddaughter, Amelia; by her brother, Robert and his wife Angie; by her sister, Paula; her nephew Evan and his daughter Rowan; her nephew Shane and his wife Alex; and last, but not least, her beloved dog, Captain, and cat Pixie.

The family is grateful for the skill and compassion shown to Diane by the ICU staff of Shadyside Hospital. She, and her family members, were treated with sensitivity and kindness by the doctors, nurses, and staff of the hospital.

Diane's final hours were spent with her family, both in person and by telephone.

Her life ended too soon, but she lived long enough for a special gift from God. She was able to hear the heartbeat of the grandchild that will be born in June

2023, and to answer "I love you, too" to her daughters. Those were her last words, and her family is grateful that she was able to say them. Her suffering has ended.
