



## Frank F. Conte

August 7, 1934 - April 15, 2024

Mr. Frank F. Conte, 89, of Cranberry Township, formerly of Greensburg, PA, passed away peacefully on April 15, 2024, surrounded by his family. He was born August 7, 1934, in Pittsburgh, PA, son of the late Frank and Linda Conte. Frank graduated from Pittsburgh Central Catholic High School (1952). He then attended the University of Notre Dame (1956), earning a degree in Chemical Engineering. He was a Midshipman in the Navy ROTC program and served 3 years as an officer in the U.S. Navy upon graduation.

After his service, he moved to Detroit Michigan to work for Wyandotte Chemical and met the love of his life Mary Ann Michel in 1960. After their wedding in August of 1961, they moved to the Pittsburgh area where he attended the University of Pittsburgh and received his MBA.

In 1970, Frank and Mary Ann moved to Greensburg, PA where they raised their 6 children. He spent the majority of his career in HVAC Commercial Contracting. Frank was an avid golfer and continuous learner and proud of his Pittsburgh roots. He was a dedicated Notre Dame football fan traveling often to attend games. He was always an active member of his home parish serving as lector and RCIA instructor.

Frank is preceded in death by his parents Frank and Linda Conte, his wife Mary Ann of 60 years, his son Frank, his brother Bob, his sister-in-law Jean, and several other extended family members. Frank is survived by his 5 loving daughters; Theresa Becht (Don), Ann Krizmanich (Mike), Kathy Prokopius (Mark), Mary Ellen Ault (Nick), and Sue De Angel (Miguel); 11 grandchildren,
