Gary J. McMullen, age 88, of Tarentum, PA, passed away peacefully on May 22, 2026, after a brief illness.

Born on November 20, 1937, in Bairdford, PA, to John L. and Helen P. McMullen (Wood), he was preceded in death by his brothers, Herbert, James, and Vern. He is survived by his sons, Gregory and Todd (Toni).

A proud Navy veteran, Gary served as a Radarman First Class aboard the USS Kearsarge (CVS-33) during the Cold War of the late 1950s and early 1960s. He then continued working at the site for the Tesone Land Company to ensure that the mine's wastewater was processed correctly until his retirement in 2024.
