



## Harry W. Doutt Sr.

March 26, 1929 - August 13, 2022

Harry Warren Doutt Sr. beloved husband and father went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, August 13, 2022 at the age of 93.

He was preceded in death by his wife Regina Ann (Stoffel) Doutt on July 20, 2011 and more recently by his brother Robert M. Doutt on May 11, 2022.

He was born March 26, 1929 in Tarentum, PA, the seventh son of James Garvin and Effie Alice (Scott) Doutt.

He was a member of the Armed Forces, serving in the Army during the Korean War. Following his honorable discharge from the Army he returned to Pennsylvania, married, and became the proud father of a daughter and two sons.

He worked for PPG Industries Twindow Plant in Creighton until he was transferred in 1969 to the newly opened PPG Plant in Meadville, PA where he was employed for 40 plus years. Living in Conneaut Lake, he enjoyed coaching American Legion baseball and watching his children participate in sports and other organized activities. Upon retirement he and his wife relocated to Florida and then Texas for several years before returning to Pennsylvania later in life to be closer to friends and family.

Harry was known to have a strong faith, inner wisdom and a loving and generous demeanor.

He is survived by his three children, three grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews.

As a loving, mature Christian, his favorite bible verse that always brought him comfort: 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 "But I would not have you to be ignorant brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.
