Jeff M. Walter, 79, of Pittsburgh, PA died on July 28, 2024. Jeff was born in Tionesta, PA, on March 29, 1945, son of the late Zella I. Barber Walter and the late Archie L. Walter. Jeff attended Strong Vincent High School before enlisting in the United States Navy. He served active duty on the USS Gainard during the Vietnam War.

After his military service Jeff attended Gannon University and worked in several technical and electrical companies in Erie, PA. He wanted to start his own contracting company in Pittsburgh and opened River City Contracting in 1980, specializing in insurance renovation.

Jeff was a board member and president of NARI, a board member of the Builders Association and founding president of their Remodel Council, served two terms as a board member of the BBB, and served a term as council member on the O'Hara Township Council. In addition, Jeff was a member of the American Legion, VFW, and Elks. He enjoyed watching football, especially the Steelers.
