Joseph Blair Hartman, 73, passed away on Thursday November 15, 2018, at his home in Ford City (Pattonville) after a long battle with prostate cancer.

Joe taught many kids in the area to hunt and quickly assumed the role of a father figure to them. He loved people and was loved by everyone that knew him.
