Of Leechburg, PA, passed away Wednesday, July 15, 2015 at Good Samaritan Hospice, Cabot, after a valiant two-year struggle with leukemia. She had a poignant determination to reach her 88th birthday, which she celebrated with humor and good cheer, surrounded by friends and family.

Lynne was born and raised in NYC in an area of Manhattan that is now the site of Lincoln Center. As a young girl, she attended dance school and went on to become a talented tap dancer. During the 1940's she traveled across the country as part of the USO Big Band Series and shared the stage with such notables as Abbott and Costello and Jerry Lewis.

In 1946 she married Orlando (Lynn) Monaco and together they had three sons; Paul, Randy, and Robert.

When that marriage ended in divorce in 1958, Lynne went to school to become a cosmetician and moved to New Rochelle, NY to raise her sons.

When her children were grown, she moved to Sarasota, Florida, where she met and married Charles Laver in 1991. In 2002 they retired and moved to Leechburg, PA.

Lynne was preceded in death by her husband; Charles, and by her two sons; Randy and Robert.

She is remembered with love by her son; Paul, and his wife Sheri, her grandchildren; Aaron (Andrea) Monaco, Colin Monaco, her great-grandchild; Paul Lennon Monaco, her step-children; Tom (Joy) Laver, Julie (Kenny) Kowalski, Cathy Blackburn, her step-grandsons; Sean (Abby) Laver, Dan (Amanda) Frost, Andrew Blackburn, loving in-laws, nieces, nephews, and a host of long-time friends.
