Marguerite Carruthers Cameron Lyle, age 90, passed peacefully in her sleep on February 5, 2023. She was born to the late William and Mary Carruthers in Oliver, Nova Scotia on October 6, 1932. Always a lover of travel, Marguerite delighted in going on cruises as well as polka dances where she met and married her second husband, John B. Lyle, who passed in 2013. They enjoyed many dances, fun trips all around the world and wonderful companionship into their twilight years. Marguerite then relocated to the home of her daughter in Fox Chapel and then eventually to The Memory Unit at Woodside Place where she was loved and treated with dignity until her death. She was known to always be smiling, dancing, and singing in the halls.
