



Oneta Doubleday

February 26, 1934 - October 25, 2022

Oneta Marie (Aynes) Doubleday, 88, of Allison Park, PA, died Oct. 25, 2022 at Passavant Hospital in McCandless, PA.

She was born on Feb. 26, 1934 in Marland, OK, to parents Eva May (Orr) and Marion Spencer Aynes. Oneta grew up and graduated from high school in Tuttle, OK, where she was class of 1952 salutatorian and a star on the basketball court.

After high school, she took a job in Oklahoma City, where she met Otis Doubleday, and they were married on Sept. 2, 1955. They had 2 children, Dennis (b. 1956) and Michael (b. 1958)

During her working life, Oneta was a bookkeeper for several financial institutions in Oklahoma City, including CIT Financial Services, Continental Bank, and MidFirst Bank.

She was very skilled at cooking, sewing and quilting, and she was proud of the many baby quilts she made for Project Linus.

She lived for 43 years in Edmond, OK before returning to Tuttle for retirement in 2005. After several falls and a heart condition left her in poor health, she moved to Hampton Fields Village in Pennsylvania in 2016 to be near her son. Despite many health challenges, including surviving cancer twice, she always kept a positive attitude about life and was always ready to have fun and not afraid to look silly. She founded and was commissioner for many years of a Wii bowling league at Hampton Fields. She also volunteered as a greeter and helped many new residents feel comfortable there.

She is survived by son Dennis and his wife Mary of McCandless, PA, grandchildren Julia of Washington, DC and Kevin of Rochester, NY, and sister Irene Hulett of Tuttle, OK.

She was preceded in death by husband Otis (2006), son Michael (2005), siblings Cleeta Rooker and Raymond Aynes, and half-siblings Erman Aynes, Carl Aynes, Clyde Aynes and Ruby Roberson.

A private family viewing was held at Thomas Smith Funeral Home in Blawnox, PA. Her ashes will be interred in the family plot at Fairview Cemetery in Tuttle, OK at a TBD date.
