Sheldon and Barbara were in love every day of their 48 years of marriage. They shared a passion for dogs, starting with show then obedience. Sheldon's favorite past time was upland hunting with his bird dogs. He hunted with Weimaraners, Brittany Spaniels, and American Water Spaniels; all whistle trained to retrieve in water as well as blindly, in which the dog follows pointing signals to find a bird they cannot see. Some of his dogs achieved Master Hunter certification, and Utility titles in obedience - both being the highest honors in their respective disciplines. Sheldon earned a brown belt in judo and black belt in karate. Yet he was a kind and gentle man, with a strong Christian faith. He welcomed the opportunity to talk religion and politics whether you agreed or disagreed with him. Sheldon always enjoyed a great laugh, even at his own expense. He was quick to praise, and never missed an offer of encouragement. He relished the solitude of country living but welcomed

visitors. As a family physician, Sheldon delivered premier care to his patients. He would often call to check up on them in the evenings. His patients loved him! He healed countless people, and even saved several lives. On occasion, a casual observation of friends outside the office would lead to critical diagnosis. He embodied the spirit of patient care, and the Hippocratic Oath.
